7.1.5 Green campus initiatives

The institutional initiatives for greening the campus include

1. The Green Campus, Energy and Environment Policy

Situated in the midst of a densely populated area in the middle of the city, in a small campus, the college's green area is very small but is a very well maintained. The college strives to maintain and improve its campus by adopting measures of Green Campus, Energy and Environment Policy.

Scope of the Policy

The Policy aims to not only at the physical development of the existing campus, it also focuses on co-curricular and extracurricular practices that encourage all stakeholders to take the lead in creating positive changes in the Global environment. These initiatives include all infrastructural, administrative activities related to energy efficiency, sustainability and the environment and activities for creating awareness in students about issues like global warming, climate change, pollution etc..

The focus areas of this policy are:

Clean Air Initiatives

Smoking Free Campus

Plastic-Free Campus

Installation of Energy Efficiency lights in classrooms

Maintenance of garden area and plants

Awareness Initiatives - Environment-Centric Student Activities

Objectives of the Policy

- To protect and conserve ecological resources within the campus.
- To ensure judicious use of environmental resources to meet the needs and aspirations of the present and future generations.
- To integrate environmental concerns into policies, plans and programs for social development and outreach.
- To work with all stakeholders and the local community to raise awareness and promote adoption of environmental good practices.
- To improve the efficient use of all resources, including energy and water, recovering and recycling waste.
- To make the campus plastic free.
- To minimize the use of paper in administration through having policy for E-governance.

The Policy:

A. Clean Campus Initiatives - The college has pledged to actively coordinate cleanliness activities within the college and beyond the campus in accordance with the vision of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. The broad vision is:

1. Generating mass awareness on cleanliness and hygiene amongst students and staff members by holding regular cleanliness drives. The idea is to motivate them to contribute in a proactive manner.
2. Activities under 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' will be a key component of all the community work being done by NSS, NCC and Rover Ranges units of the college.
3. Events such as painting, poster and slogan competitions, essay writing, speeches, skits on 'Swachh Bharat' will be organised.

4. Rallies on themes connected with 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' in and around the college campus will be conducted to create mass awareness.
5. Removal of all kinds of waste material like broken furniture, unusable equipment etc will be undertaken.
6. Pledge by students and staff members to maintain cleanliness of the college campus and its surrounding areas on an annual basis.
7. Conduct workshops on the 3Rs: Reduce, reusing and recycling of waste.

B. Landscaping Initiatives - The campus landscape is a vital part of the life of a campus, providing space for study, events, and aesthetic appreciation. The landscape of trees and plants is maintained to provide the students and staff with clean and cool environment. The painting Department undertakes the responsibility of engaging its students in decorating the walls of the college in beautiful colors and maintaining the symbiotic relation of the institution with nature.

Policy measures proposed are

1. Organizing annual tree plantation drives
2. Encouraging student societies to hold tree planting events
3. Smoking Free Campus

C. Infrastructural Initiatives – The college is dedicated to minimize and sustainably manage its use of electricity. The college believes in reducing the consumption of electricity. The college is committed to using cleaner energy such as LED lighting. The college proposes to build a policy to achieve the 3Rs of environment friendliness (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle) – waste product management, reduction in use of paper, reduction in requirement of printed books by updating the e-books and e-journals collection of the college library, initiatives to spread awareness amongst students about reusing and recycling non-biodegradable products, organization of workshops for students on solid waste management, prompt repair water leakages in campus.

D. Awareness Initiatives Outreach and education are of utmost importance so that all members of the campus community aid in the implementation of the policy. The college encourages awareness campaigns, seminars, workshops, conferences and other interactive sessions to facilitate effective implementation of the Green Campus, Energy and Environment

policies. NSS, NCC and Rover Ranger Units organize events, competitions and training sessions to bring about positive environmental changes at the grassroots level.

E. Conduct Green Audit The college proposes to conduct a Green Audit of the college campus to assess our strengths and weaknesses to further our goals of long-term sustainability. A green audit will be undertaken as a useful tool to determine how and where most energy or water or resources are being used and make modifications for improvements. Programs are proposed to be organized to create health consciousness and promote environmental values and ethics. Green auditing will promote financial savings through reduction of resource use. It is imperative that the college evaluate its own contributions toward a sustainable future.
