### 7.1.7 The Institution has disabled-friendly, barrier free environment

#### **The college is built environment with ramps for easy access to classrooms/Hall.**

The college has formulated a policy to keep the campus disabled friendly and to take every possible measure to provide a barrier free environment to the Divyangian. The policy has been formulated to reduce social exclusion and encourage the students with disabilities and to generate an awareness in their peer group on their role in inclusion of people with disabilities by respecting the rights and dignity of each individual. The objective of the policy is to make our campus disabled-friendly, within its limitations, by providing students with disabilities suited infrastructure, within the limitations of the existing campus. The Hall of the college, used for organizing co-curricular and extra-curricular activities has been provided with hand rails for the stairs leading to the auditorium.

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#### **OBJECTIVES**

The objective of the policy is to make our campus disabled-friendly, within its limitations, by providing students with disabilities suitable infrastructure and facilities of support and sensitised atmosphere

#### **POLICY MEASURES**

- Ensuring admission of students from all social milieus and their empowerment through mentoring and counselling.
- Strict implementation of admission policies for people with disabilities in accordance with the updated guidelines for admission of the UGC/affiliating University

- Upgrading campus infrastructure to make it more accessible for people with disabilities by ramps, railings, accessible washrooms for disabled students, wheelchairs,
- Organization of awareness and sensitization programs and events for able-bodied staff and students to make the College a safe space for people with disabilities.
- Organization of academic and cultural activities, training, short-term courses and workshops specially designed to cater to the needs of students with disabilities.
- Counselling and additional support
- A reading table closer to the entrance of library specially set apart for the differently abled students.
- Provision of a wheelchair for differently abled students in the campus.
- At the time of admission, a Helpdesk for the differently abled students seeking admission.
